

## **Conflict Minerals -policy**

If the delivered materials/products contain any of tin, tantalum, gold, or tungsten, suppliers are required to comply with the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and points on the Consumer Protection Act 2010 – legislation of conflict minerals and to certify that none of these minerals cannot originate from the Democratic Republic of the Congo or any of its neighboring countries.

Muuntosähkö Oy - Trafox take seriously the problem of conflict minerals and attends to the problem solving together with suppliers through the supply chain.

Muuntosähkö Oy - Trafox the basic principles of conflict minerals are:

Refrain from using gold, tantalum, tungsten and tin, which are classified as conflict minerals, which means the Democratic Republic of the Congo and its neighboring countries in armed conflicts or irregularity extracted minerals.

If any of the raw material, which Muuntosähkö Oy - Trafox buy from a third-party supplier, is found to be in conflict minerals, Muuntosähkö Oy - Trafox immediately stop procurement from the supplier.
